

Angels

Supplies per child:

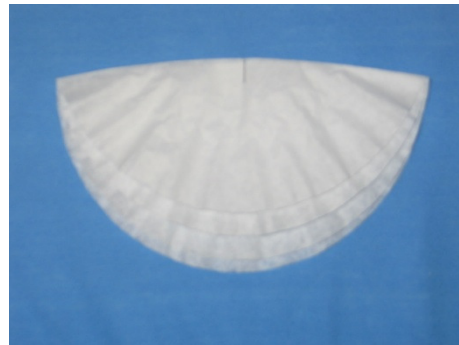
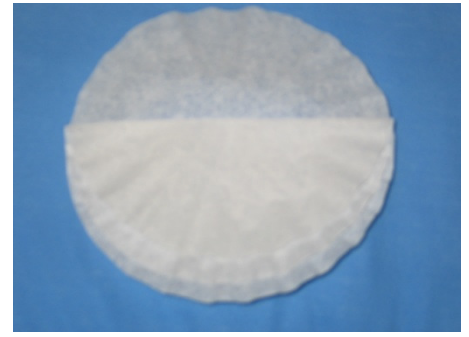
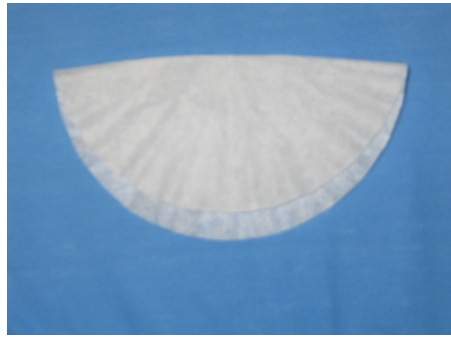
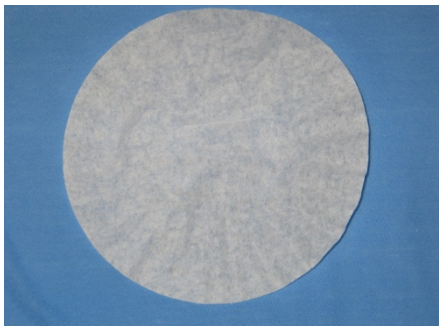
- 2 coffee filters
- $\frac{1}{2}$ a craft stick (tongue depressor)
- magnet
- silver or gold pipe cleaner (chenille)
- silver or gold bow (needs to be pre-made)
- silver or gold baking cup cut in $\frac{1}{2}$
- scissors

** Pie plates for glue 2 per table

**1 stapler per table

Set out

- coffee filters (2 per child)
- pie plates for glue (2 per table)
- Q-tips (1 per child)



Step 1

1. Open up and flatten 1 of the coffee filters
2. Take the top of the coffee filter and fold it over. Stagger the edges slightly so you see 2 edges.
3. Take the other coffee filter and flatten.
4. Place the first coffee filter on top of this one and set it along the bottom so that now you see 3 edges.
5. Then fold the filter downwards so that you now see 4 edges.
The skirt!
6. Fold the skirt in half to make a crease.
7. Teacher staples at the crease

Get supplies (1 wing to cut, bow, pipe cleaner for halo, magnet)

Step 2

1. Cut wing in half
2. Flip the skirt over so you do not see the ruffles of the skirt. Take the $\frac{1}{2}$ craft stick and put glue on the bottom part below the line. Have the pencil line level with the top of the skirt. Hold for 30 sec. Stick Label with Name on it to the back of skirt.
3. Put a tiny bit of glue on the tip of one wing. Glue it to the back. Then do the same to the other side.
4. Take the magnet and bend it back and forth so it is not curved. Take sticky stuff off magnet and stick to back of stick. (middle)



Step 3

1. Looking at front of angel draw a face using the marker.
2. Use Q-tip with blush for the cheeks of the angel.
3. Make halos by twisting the pipe cleaner.
4. Teacher will hot glue gun bows and halos

Step 4 (Next Day)

1. Drizzle glue on the skirt of the angel and sprinkle sparkles.
