Procedure:

- A committee of at least three provincial executive members to include the Awards and Bursaries Coordinator may select one recipient per year.
- The committee shall not be required to award a life membership each year.
- The recipient of the award will be acknowledged at an ECEC event and on the ECEC website.

Guidelines for Selection of Candidates:

1)The candidate must be currently working with children 3-8 years of age; a retired or superannuated teacher; and/or early childhood professional equivalent (ie. Professor, lecturer in early childhood, daycare worker).

2)The candidate must further qualify in one or more of the following areas of early childhood through active involvement (two or more years of service):

- Member of the Provincial Executive or Member-at-Large/Executive Assistant
- Member of a Local Executive
- Chairperson or Committee member of an ECEC Conference
- Original Founding Member
- Demonstrated active involvement in ECEC activities in Saskatchewan (published articles, innovative projects, workshop presenter, etc.)
