How does our world change with the seasons?

Students use the inquiry that was done in previous lessons and create a piece of work to show their knowledge gained concerning how plants, animals, and humans adapt to the daily and seasonal changes.

- 1. Students are given a large sheet of paper to draw a story map. Ask them to create a MOVIE about the seasons. Their movie must have at least four pictures/ screens.
- **EXTENTION ACTIVITY** Students who are able to can do the above but also add the transitional events that occur between the seasons.(8 boxes)
- 2. Students have the <u>choice</u> between making a "roll out" movie that can be shown and talked about with the teacher, or create a large scale drawing that can "filmed" using flip videos and "voice over".
- 3. Students are given a checklist of items that must be included in their movie.
 - Have I included a person in each of the boxes that tells about each of the seasons?
 - Is my person doing a different activity in each of the boxes?
 - Have I included an animal in each of the boxes that shows how animals adapt/change with the seasons?
 - Have I included a plant in each of the boxes that shows how plants change?
 - Can I tell the story of how the world changes with the seasons.
- 4. Have the students practice telling one another their stories and reflect on the checklist.
